GOATS

Check In: Saturday 4 pm to 7 pm

Judging and Showmanship: Wednesday 9 am

- a. Any livestock unloaded before being checked in will be disqualified and removed from the fairgrounds.
- b. Your goat **must have** to be allowed at fair: either a scrapie tag in the ear, scrapie tag number tattooed in the ear or flank with tag carried with goat, a breed association registry tattoo with the registration certificate carried with the goat, or pygmy goats can be microchipped but must carry the registration papers with the goat and provide a microchip reader. If a goat is not tagged or does not have a legible tattoo they will be sent home.
- c. All goat kids born for the 2019 Fair need to be born by April 1st. This applies to all breeds and includes does and wethers. Possession date for all goats is May 1st.
- d. Exhibitors limited to 1 entry per class and can bring total of 4 goats.
- e. Any classes can be changed or combined due to size by Superintendents
- f. Breeding stock may be shown with or without horns if Breed Standard allows (Angora, Pygmy, Meat breeds). Meat wethers may be shown with or without horns. All Dairy breeds & Pygmy wethers must be dehorned. All dehorned goats must have "healed horns".
- g. Total of 2 goats may be sold at auction. All Meat Goat wethers and Dairy Market wethers must be sold at the auction.
- h. In addition to fair entry forms, 4-H goat registration forms must be turned in at the mandatory paperwork check in on May 4th from 9am to 11am at the Extension office.
- i. All livestock exhibitors shall comply with the most current MDA health requirements for livestock exhibited in Michigan. All livestock exhibitors shall also comply with the rules & bylaws of both Large & Small Animal Associations, 4-H Jackson Co. Goat project, & all rules & requirements of the Jackson Co Fair.
- j. CHECKOUT & CLEANUP:
Decoration tear down Saturday 10pm to 11pm or Sunday 9am to 11am
Goat check out Sunday **only** 9am to 11am.
Pens must be cleaned by 11am on Sunday. Animals not picked up by 11am on Sunday will be disposed of at superintendents' discretion.

SECTION 1 – Nubian

Exhibitor and Owner shall be the same person.

Class:

75. Spring Doe Kid (born January 15, 2019 to April 1, 2019)
76. Junior Yearling Doe (born October 1, 2018 to January 14, 2019)
77. Dry Doe Yearling (born before October 1, 2018 but under 2 years)
78. Yearling Milker (1 year but under 2 years)
79. Junior Milker (2 years but under 3 years)
80. Senior Milker (3 years and older)
81. Dam and Daughter (must be owned and shown by same exhibitor, and registered and shown in individual classes)

82. Dairy Market Wether (born after December 1st of fair year and Full Blood Dairy Breeds only. Must be sold at auction).

83. Homegrown Dairy Market Wether class (must also be registered in market wether class).

Homegrown must be born and raised on Exhibitor's or Exhibitor's grandparent's farm and be the owner of the doe.

Exhibitor and Owner shall be the same person.

88. Dam & Daughter (animal must be owned and shown by same exhibitor, and registered and shown in individual classes)

SECTION 9 – Wether Costume Class

Exhibitor and Owner shall be the same person.

Class:

89. Hobby Wether Costume Class (Pygmy/Pygmy Cross wethers, Nigerian/Nigerian Cross wethers, Angora wethers ONLY. Do not have to be sold.)

90. Market Wether Costume Class. (Dairy or Meat Wethers ONLY. Must be sold at auction and also registered/shown in either Market Wether Class 82 or Class 97).

SECTION 10 – Meat Goats and Meat Crossbreeds including Boer/Dairy crossbreeds

Exhibitor and Owner shall be the same person.

Class:

91. Spring Doe Kid (born January 15, 2019 to April 1, 2019)

92. Junior Yearling Doe (born October 1, 2018 to January 14, 2019)

93. Yearling Doe (born before October 1, 2018 but under 2 years)

94. Junior Doe (2 years but under 3 years)

95. Senior Doe (3 years and older)

96. Dam and Daughter (must be owned and shown by same exhibitor, and registered and shown in individual classes)

97. Meat & Meat Cross Market Wether (born after December 1st of fair year and must be sold).

98. Homegrown Meat Market Wether class (must also be registered in market wether class)

Homegrown must be born and raised on Exhibitor's or Exhibitor's grandparent's farm and be the owner of the doe.
